DT—584 Providence, Predestination, & the Prob. of Pain

This course surveys the questions of God's guiding providence over all of creation, particularly as this intersects with human free will. The course will also focus on the relation of divine providence and human free will in our salvation, as well as the question of how God's providence can allow suffering in the world. Attention will be given to both classical source such as St. Augustine and St. Thomas Aquinas, as well as contemporary contributions to these problems. The course will seek to synthesize both a speculative theological approach with practical, pastoral responses to these difficult questions.
