#### 2020 Msgr. Schuler Seminarian Fund Application

The application for the 2020 Msgr. Richard J. Schuler Seminarian Award is now available on-line. All applications should be completed using the online form.

Catholic United Financial Foundation established the Msgr. Richard J. Schuler Seminarian Charitable Fund in 1996 to honor his 30 years as the Spiritual Director of Catholic United Financial and to commemorate his years of priestly service. Although Msgr. Schuler is no longer with us, his legacy of assisting Seminarians will continue through the Endowment Fund.

Since 1996, the Fund has grown to over \$900,000 from donations by individuals, members and our Parish Volunteer Teams and Councils. The fund has distributed \$773,550 through 2,188 Seminarian grants since its inception.

The fund is unique in that it provides support to seminarians in genuine financial need to cover basic living expenses, books, transportation, and/or other incidental expenses, not covered by other sources. Grants are awarded annually to seminarians who are studying for the priesthood in the following Dioceses and Archdioceses:

St. Paul/ Minneapolis, Bismarck, Crookston, Dubuque, Duluth, Fargo, La Crosse, New Ulm, Rapid City, Saint Cloud, Sioux Falls, Sioux City, Superior, and Winona-Rochester.

Please note that each applicant is required to have a letter of recommendation from an official of the seminary where they are attending (e-mail is acceptable).
