

2024 Dehon Lecture

On October 16, Robert G Kennedy, PhD Professor of Catholic Studies at the University of St Thomas gave this year's Dehon Lecture. Dr. Kennedy's lecture was titled "The Work of the Church is Charity" The lecture explored the implications of this theme in three respects: why charity ought to be the foundation of the Church's work in the world, what this suggests for pastoral ministry in the social arena, and how our perspective on some current issues might be modified if viewed through the lens of charity. Dr. James Stroud, SHSST Associate Professor of Moral Theology was the respondent to Dr. Kennedy's lecture in the afternoon.
