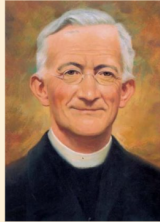

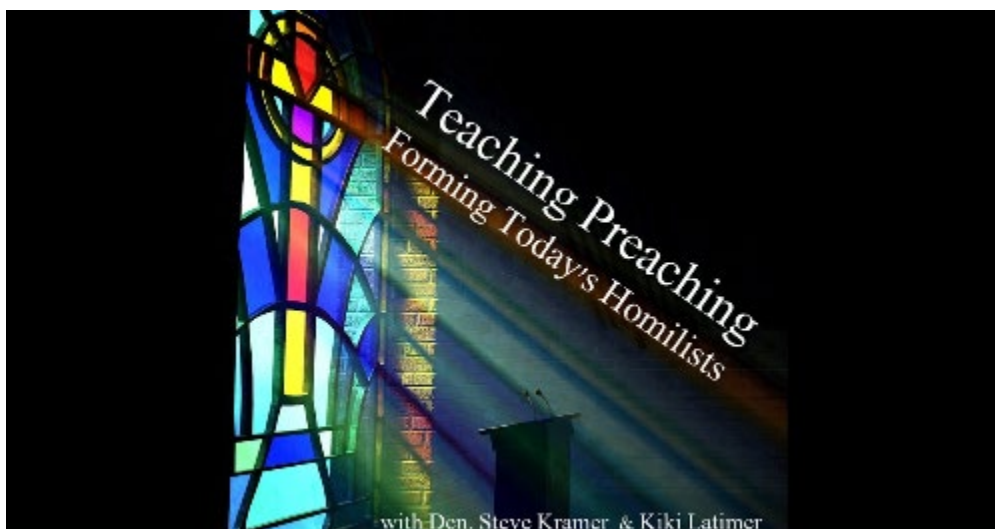
“Lent as a Path into the Paschal Mystery”

On Ash Wednesday, March 05, Deacon Dominic Cerrato, Ph.D., led a Day of Recollection titled *Conformed to Christ the Servant: Lent as a Path into the Paschal Mystery*. This opportunity provided seminarians, faculty, and staff with a deeper understanding of how the Lenten season can draw them into greater communion with Christ the Servant, particularly in the context of Holy Orders. Through two insightful sessions—*The Primacy of the Interior Life (Breathing In)* and *The Necessity of the Exterior Life (Breathing Out)*—participants reflected on the essential balance between interior spiritual formation and its outward expression in service. The day served as a meaningful opportunity for renewal, guiding attendees to embrace Lent as a transformative journey into the Paschal Mystery.

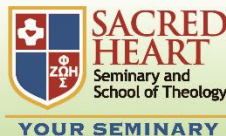
